Subsurface Utilities Engineering (SUE)- - -

FXSA, Inc. completes three SUE projects in El Paso- - -

Our firm successfully completed three (3) SUE projects in the El Paso area in the last three months. All three projects consisted of providing professional SUE services Level A to locate underground utilities.

The first project consisted of probing approximately 14,000’ of a 36” Concrete Water Main at every 100’ along

Paisano Drive in the Westside of El Paso, Texas. The SUE services were provided for Brown & Caldwell Environmental Engineers and Consultants, who were the prime engineering consultants for the El Paso Water Utilities (EPWU). The project consisted of designating and locating the water main under paved areas and natural ground on TxDOT R.O.W. Permitting

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for these services was also a major component of the Scope of Work.

The second project consisted of performing professional SUE services up to Level A to designate and locate all underground utilities under Horizon Blvd. (Buford Rd.) from Alameda Ave. (SH-20) to North Loop Dr. (SH-76) in Socorro, Texas. These services were provided for Huitt-Zollars under a contract with TxDOT – El Paso District.

The third project consisted of performing professional SUE services up to Level A to designate and locate all underground utilities that could be in conflict with the Fred Miller water main on the Westside of El Paso, Texas. Professional services were provided for S & B Infrastructure for a project with EPWU as well.
